provides a safe, sober and supportive school environment in which youth in recovery can develop the skills and strengths needed for personal, academic, vocational, and community success. Ostiguy High incorporates seven distinct though highly integrated components. While the objectives of academic competency and progress toward high school graduation are a primary focus, there is an equal commitment to a comprehensive recovery program that includes an individualized contract with the youth, commitment to their recovery, linkage with a behavioral health clinician when necessary, family support, and comprehensive care management and resource coordination.
